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TAKING CONTROL OF YOU FINANCES

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The first and most important factor in taking control of the financial aspect of your life is budgeting. You cannot save or spend money appropriately without having a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly budget that tracks your earnings and spending. Knowing where your money is going is important in reducing unnecessary expenses, and increasing the money saved for you financial cushion. To get started you will need to write down all of your monthly expenses (rent/mortgage, car payments, student loans, energy bills, & food) and deduct your take home earnings. Creating and sticking to your budget will help you better understand your cash flow, and bring you a step closer to reaching your financial goals.

Three tricks to helping you stay on budget

- 1) Set aside time each week to work on your budget
- 2) The Green Experiment: Use cash for all of your living expenses (food, clothing, gas). Withdraw cash in the beginning of each week for your budgeted living expenses. Seeing the money leave your hand, will make you think twice about overspending.
- 3) Track your budget by using an Excel spreadsheet or online tools.
